#### **Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

- **Capitalization Resolution**: Supervisor Gray presented to the Board a proposed Capitalization Policy (Resolution 2025-3) which would establish a series of depreciation methods for assets owned or held by the Township. The proposed policy would be in compliance with Governmental Accounting Standards Board Statement number 34. A motion was made by Becky Cross and seconded by Laura Renn to adopt the proposed resolution. Motion carried.

#### **Monthly Claims:**

- Road and Bridge Fund, Building and Equipment Fund and Permanent Road Fund claims were presented to the Board for review. Motion by Kyle Ingram and seconded by Becky Cross to pay those bills. Motion carried.
- Town Fund and Social Security Fund claims were also presented to the Board. Motion byKyle Ingram and seconded by Becky Cross to pay those bills. Motion carried.
